

**BREVARD ACADEMY FAMILY AGREEMENT  
2009-20010**

The mission of Brevard Academy is to prepare its students to achieve excellence in higher education and in the world-at-large by providing an environment that fosters creativity and independent thinking. The school will encourage all students to excel within their own frameworks of talent and ambition, to become well informed, and to love learning for its own sake. As a partnership involving students, teachers, and parents, the school will promote development of sound moral character, leadership, commitment to the community, and high academic standards.

In order to accomplish the above mission, Brevard Academy will need the help and cooperation of parents. We believe that parental presence in the school will contribute to learning through the example set by committed, caring adults. Parental and student commitment to the following agreement is requested.

**Students are expected to:**

- Attend school punctually and regularly. Absences may be excused with an explanatory note from a parent.
- Obey the rules and regulations of the school.
- Be courteous, obedient, and respectful to all school staff and personnel.
- Be respectful and considerate of classmates.
- Be diligent in study.
- Complete homework assignments on time and in good order.
- Adhere to the Brevard Academy Honor Code.

**As a parent/guardian of a Brevard Academy student, I agree:**

- To supervise my child’s homework habits and see to it that assignments are completed on time and in good order by my child.
- To serve in the school as a teaching assistant, special teacher or in some other role as agreed to by the school Principal for two (2) hours monthly, per parent, there being nine such monthly periods in the school year. One parent may serve the hours for both parents if desired.
- To provide lunch for my child on a daily basis, as the school will not be operating a cafeteria.
- To provide timely transportation for my child to and from school each day, as the school will not be operating school buses. If lack of transportation is a barrier to attendance at Brevard Academy, special arrangements will be made between parent(s) and the school to provide transportation.
- That my child will be bound by the terms of the **Brevard Academy Honor Code** as follows:

**“I promise to be honest and trustworthy  
and to uphold these qualities in myself and others.”**

A student may be expelled from the school if, in the opinion of the Principal, there has been sufficient violation of the rules or conduct as established by his or her teacher(s) that continued attendance would be disruptive or dangerous to other students and/or staff, recognizing the requirements of the state and federal law concerning special needs students. Expulsion may also occur if a student violated the Brevard Academy Honor Code, or if a student or his or her parent(s) fails to adhere to the terms of the Brevard Academy Family Agreement.

Rest assured that the Principal of Brevard Academy will have the discretion to enforce the Honor Code with all due consideration given to the age of the student and other relevant circumstances.
