Tobacco-Free Environment

Per N.C.G.S. §115C-407, Brevard Academy shall prohibit at all times the use of any tobacco or nicotine product by any person in school buildings, in school facilities, on school campuses, and in or on any other school property owned or operated by Brevard Academy: Challenge Foundation Academy. These include but are not limited to cigarettes, chewing tobacco, vapes, etc.

Brevard Academy will prohibit advertising in the form of tobacco industry sponsorship (e.g., contributions, financial support, material paid for or produced by the tobacco industry).

Enforcement

Disciplinary consequences for policy violations will be handled in partnership between the school administration and the school resource officer.

Brevard Academy will clearly display signage prohibiting the use of all tobacco products on school property.

Prevention and Treatment Services

Those employees in violation of the policy will be referred to tobacco cessation resources provided by the National Alliance on Mental Illness at <u>https://naminc.org/smoking-cessation/</u>.
