

Background and Purpose Statement: Brevard Academy offers a rigorous curriculum. It is our intention to challenge students who show demonstrated readiness for advanced mathematics. Math 1 is an advanced level, high school math course. Students are able to earn high school math credit.

Students will be given the option to take Math 1 in 8th grade if they meet one of the pathways below.

**Pathway 1:** 70% or higher on End of Year Math MAP **and** a Level IV or higher on EOG.

**Pathway 2:** 60%-69% on End of Year Math MAP **and** a Level IV higher on Math EOG **and** two teacher recommendations.

**Pathway 3:** 70% or higher on End of Year Math MAP **and** a Level III on EOG **and** two teacher recommendations.

**Pathway 4:** End of Year A's in math in both 6th and 7th grade **and** a Level III or higher on Math EOG in both 6th and 7th grade **and** two teacher recommendations.

Parent Appeal Process:

- Parents may appeal a recommendation using the Parent Appeal form.
- Appeals will be made to the School Director.
- The School Director will inform the family of the school's decision.

Transfer Students: Students who transfer to our school during the 8th grade, we will be offered the opportunity to take Math I class if they were recommended for it by their previous school, or if they received a Level 4 on the NC Math EOG during their 7th-grade year.
