

**Purpose:** Brevard Academy is a uniform school because we believe that uniforms create a sense of belonging, reduces the financial burden placed on families by providing school clothing, and help to provide a distraction-free environment.

**School Expectations:** We expect students to come to school dressed in school uniform. If a student does not comply with the school uniform policy, parents/guardians will be notified and required to bring their child the correct uniform attire. We offer a variety of uniform options for students. We encourage all families to help their children make school-appropriate choices.

Logoed attire can only be purchased from approved vendors. Please see our website for approved vendors.

### **TOPS**

Shirts, Tops, Blouses, Sweatshirts, Sweaters - Must be from a certified vendor and have a Brevard Academy logo.

Colors: Evergreen or White (White t-shirts will be phased out after the 2023-2024 school year).

When layering a long-sleeved shirt under a short-sleeved shirt, the long-sleeved shirt must be either evergreen or white.

**Dresses/Jumpers:** Dresses and jumpers must be purchased with one of the approved school logos applied.

Colors: Navy, Tan (Khaki), Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid from approved vendors only.

These items can be purchased through Land's End (school number 900143991). For jumpers, the top under the jumper would not have to have the school logo, however, it must be White or Evergreen in color.

### **BOTTOMS**

Pants, Skirts, Shorts, Skorts, and Leggings

Colors: Navy, Tan, or Khaki. All pants must be solid in color without a design or pattern.

Notes: No Denim.

Pants, skirts, shorts, skorts, and leggings may be purchased from any store as long as the school colors are selected (no denim). Land's End will carry the appropriate colors but only for the convenience of one-stop shopping.

Also, through Land's End some styles of shorts have been selected to have an option for applying the school logo, this is not required.

The length of skirts, shorts, and skirts must be of modest length (at or below the fingertips with hands at one's side).

**Tights:** To be worn under dresses, skirts, or jumpers.  
Colors: Navy, White, Khaki

## **FOOTWEAR**

**Shoes:** No special shoes are required, but due to the outdoor environment of Brevard Academy CFA grounds, they must be closed-toe and closed-heeled and tied/fastened at all times.

**Socks:** Socks with inappropriate language or images are not allowed. Students wearing such items will need to call home and wait in the office for appropriate items to be brought to school.

## **OUTERWEAR**

Any jacket or coat worn inside a school building must be an approved article of clothing with the school logo visible.

Outerwear with inappropriate language or images is not allowed. Students wearing such items will need to call home and wait in the office for appropriate items to be brought to school. We encourage but do not require, parents, to buy BA headgear.

## **UNDERGARMENTS**

All uniforms must be worn in such a manner that undergarments are not visible either through the clothing or as a result of loose or ill-fitting clothing items.

## **Spirit Wear/Dress Downs/Pack Wear/Blue Zones**

### **Spirit wear**

Spirit Wear is defined as any BA-CFA Athletic or BA-CFA Club-related shirt that the student has earned by being part of a team or purchasing.

- K-4 Mondays only.
- 5-8 Students are allowed to wear spirit wear any day of the week.

### **Pack Wear**

- Pack wear may be worn on designated Pack Days only.

### **Blue Zones**

- Blue Zone apparel may be worn on Wednesdays during the 2023-2024 school year.

### **Student Recognition**

- When students are being recognized, they must be in school uniform.

### **Accessories/Headgear**

Accessories and headgear that cause a distraction to the learning environment are not allowed. Costume headbands are not allowed at Brevard Academy.

Hats and sunglasses are not allowed to be worn inside the building. We encourage but do not require, parents, to buy BA headgear.

**Student Recognition/Performance Attire**

Tops

Kindergarten – 3rd-grade students may wear any regular school uniform attire, we encourage them to dress nicely with a collared shirt (polo or oxford).

4th - 8th students: White Collared Shirt (with logo). Shirt length for girls can be ¾ or long sleeve.

Bottoms

Navy pants or skirts. Shoes and socks must be dark-colored

Travel Band

Students in travel will need to follow the Travel Band Director's instructions for performance wear.
